Fantasy has elements that do not exist in the real world.

- A key element is magic, but other elements can be:
- Talking animals or objects
 - Inhuman beings or creatures
 - Super/magical powers
 - Hero's weapon
 - Different languages
 - Epic battle of Good vs. Evil

Comprehension Tips

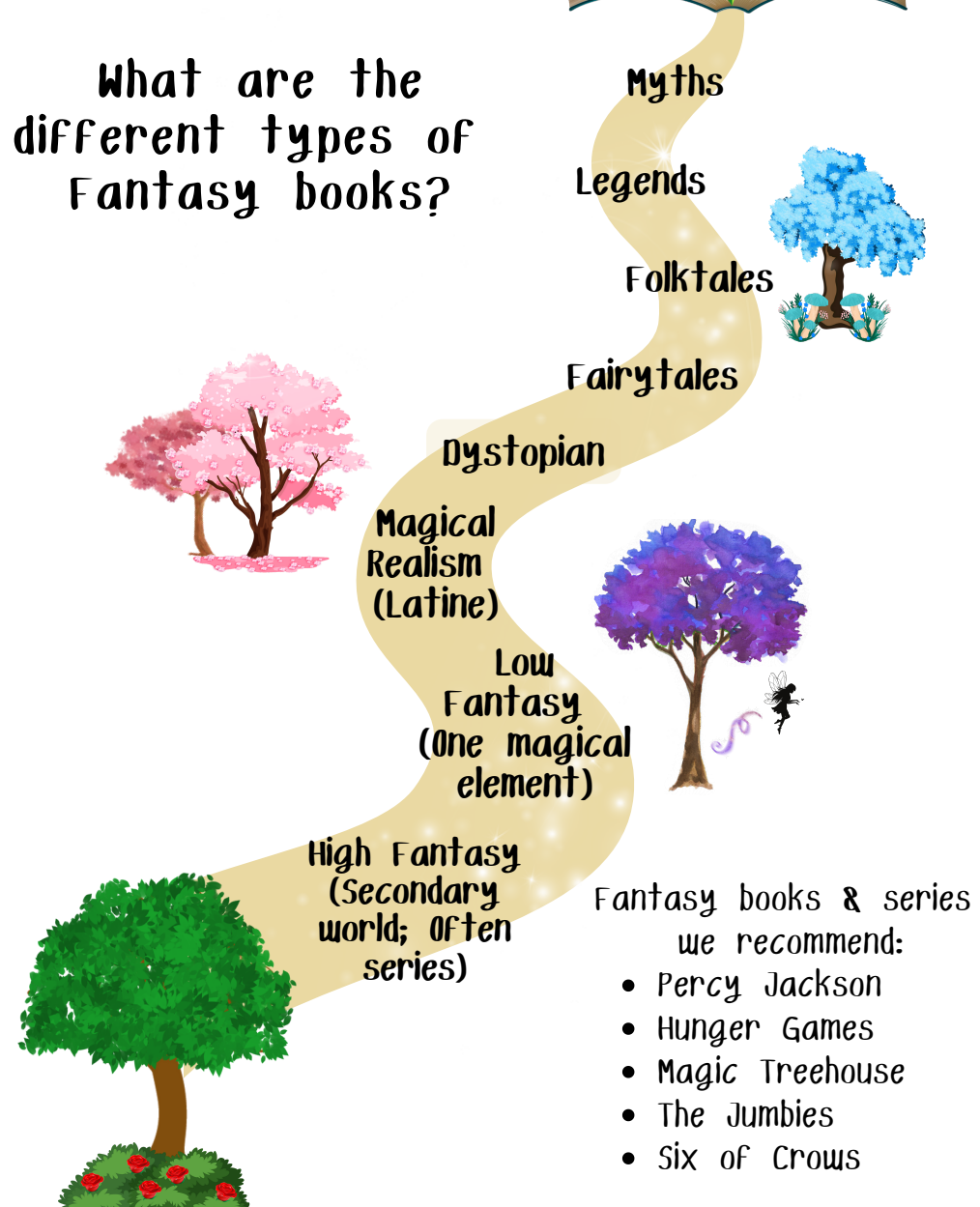
Explore the world: Pay close attention to the characters and the "rules" of the world that the author builds.

Use the map: Maps are often included in the book and will help you keep track of where the characters are in the fantasy world.

Helpful Information

Fantasy books may be slow to start as the author builds the world, but stick with it! All of the pieces come together and will often set you on a path, especially if there is another book in the series.
